

Reception Homework

Throughout the year we will send home topic tips, outlining different activities that you can do at home to support your child's learning. This will link with the seven areas of learning: Communication and Language, Personal and Social Development, Physical Development, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design.



In addition, we will send home weekly Phonics work to help reinforce what we are learning in class. This will include the songs that we sing to help the children remember different letter sounds. Later in the year homework will be introduced linked to Mathematics.

Homework will be sent home every Monday and should be returned to school on the Friday.

When the children have been introduced to the first few sets of letters and sounds they will be taught how to blend the sounds together for reading. At this point they will be given a home reading book and a word card. The word cards will contain some 'tricky' words that will be highlighted in red. Please encourage your child to learn to read these through sight recognition as these are the words which are most frequently found in books. Please practise the Jolly Phonics sounds, words on cards and reading book with your child. The reading book and word card should be kept in your child's book bag and sent into school every day.
