With You Always - What stays the same?

- 7 monthly sessions (with the same breaks for Advent and Lent)
- Follows the liturgical year
- Family Catechesis parents and children sitting together
- Catechists supporting parents, leading sessions
- Much of the same content (including Treasure Hunt)

With You Always - What is new?

- Confirmation as a topic has been removed. Confirmation is mentioned but not explained in depth
- More information about living as Jesus taught (The Beatitudes Session 4)
- Two sessions about the Eucharist (6 & 7)
- Some new illustrations
- New, friendlier parent page design
