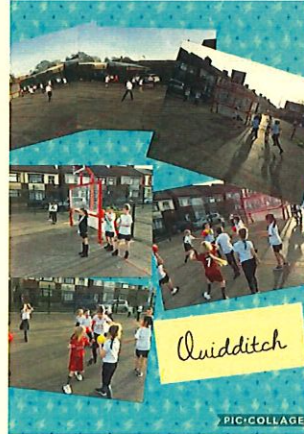

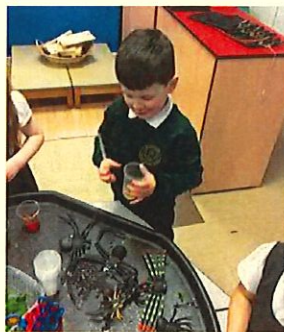
PTFA

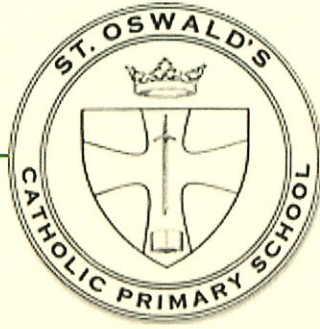
