

Draw a sun and a cloud on a sandwich bag, then fill it with half a cup of water and tape it securely to the window. When it gets warmer, you will see the water evaporate up towards the clouds and then when it gets cooler it will run down the bag like rain!</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Sustainable art</p> <p>Ask a grown up if you can use an old plastic bag. Cut the bag into strips and try to plait or twist them to create something new! How does this change our planet? What positive changes can we make?</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>We are all God’s treasures! What does this mean?</p> <p>Create a picture full of God’s treasures in our world. Are all the treasures human? What else have you drawn?</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>One of God’s main treasures is water. Not everyone in our world has access to clean and safe water.</p> <p>Answer the question ‘What can you do to save water?’ Make a list of ideas on a white board or design a ‘Save water’ poster and include within it examples of how they link this to being <i>God’s treasure</i>.</p>	<p><b>Physical activity</b></p> <p>Find a safe step, or something you can step up and down on, and time yourself to see how many times you can step up and down in 30 seconds.</p> <p>Predict how many you might do in 1 minute. Time yourself and see if your prediction was correct!</p>
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
