Activity Two: An important part of a good joke is the delivery — this is what comedians call 'telling the joke'. Even the funniest joke won't make people laugh if it's not told in a funny way. Tell these jokes to someone in your class. Think about your delivery. Use lots of expression in your voice. You might include a pause before the punchline (the bit that makes the joke funny). If you're telling a joke that needs a response (such as a knock-knock joke), make sure you leave enough time. Some comedians make people laugh because they themselves laugh while telling the joke. Other comedians are funny because they tell jokes with a straight face.
