

World values auction: team sheet

Your challenge

- Find a team of four or five people.
- Your team will be given a card with a photograph of someone from around the world and information about their home, family, life and interests.
- Your team will be given some money with which to bid at an auction, representing the person on your card.
- You will need to think about what things would be important to the person for whom you are bidding.

Here are some questions to help you to think about what would be important to the person on your card:

- 1. Where does s/he live?
- 2. What is family life like?
- 3. What kind of responsibilities does s/he have to the family and the wider community?
- 4. Does s/he go to school or work, or both?
- 5. How does s/he earn money to buy food, clothes or books?
- 6. What about leisure activities, interests, hobbies?
- 7. Do you think life is hard for him/her?
- 8. Do you think life is happy for him/her?
- 9. What makes life the way that it is in this person's country?
- 10. What about the influence or support of the country's government? Do you think the government helps people?
- 11. What could s/he do to make this better?
- 12. What could the rest of the world do to make it better?
- 13. What do you know about the Church in this country?
- 14. Is the Church a help and a comfort to this person?
- 15. Could you be this person, step into his or her shoes? If not, why not?
