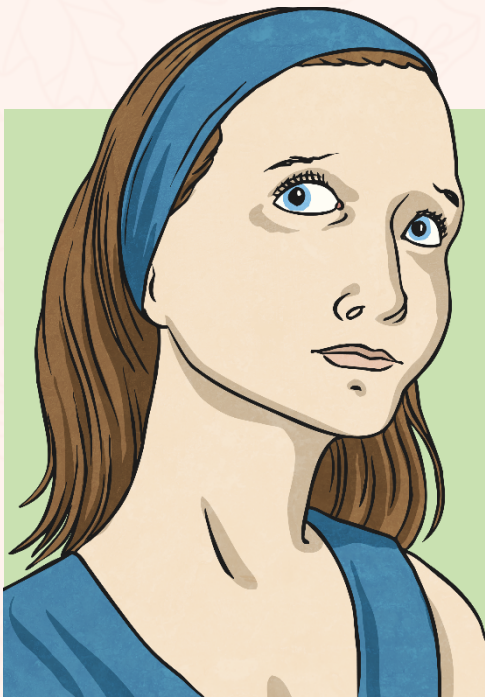


Turning -ent Adjectives into -ency/-ence Nouns



Many adjectives in the English language end in the same sound made with either **-ant** or **-ent**.

For our last set of spellings, we practised spelling **-ant** adjectives that became **-ance** or **-ancy**, e.g.



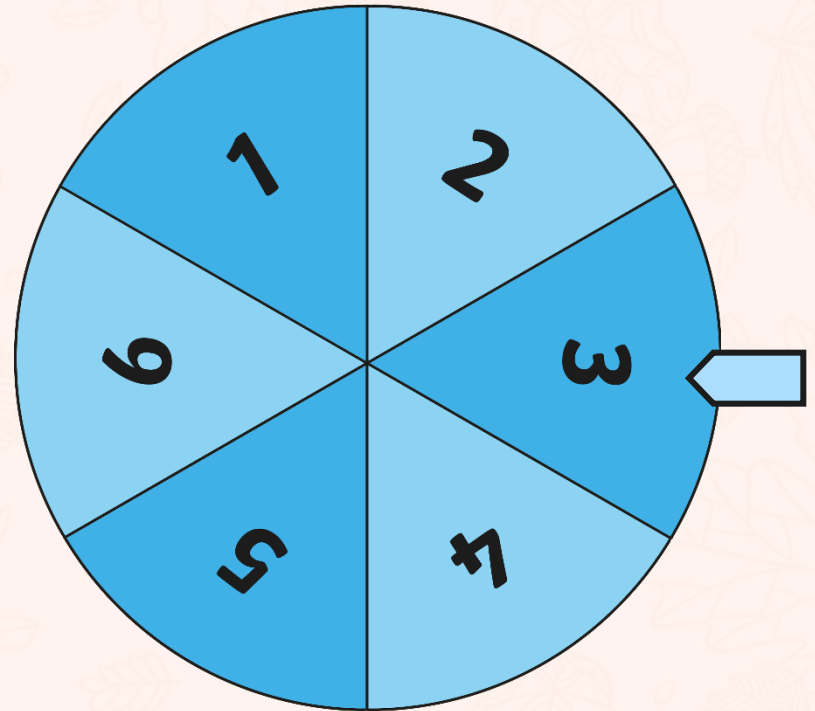
hesitant → hesitancy

For this set of spellings, we are now practising spelling **-ent** adjectives that become **-ence** or **-ency** nouns.
