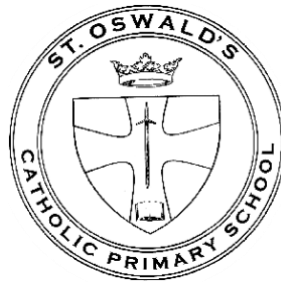

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### **Religious Education Catch Up Curriculum Vision**

As we welcome our children and families back to school after an enforced absence due to Covid-19 and the annual summer holidays. We as a Catholic school continue to teach our children that Christ is at the centre of our lives – guiding us along the path he has chosen for us.

During our time apart, we have endeavoured to bring the Word of God into our children's homes – Bringing the Gospel to them - for them to share with their families, with daily prayers and reflections to share as well as appropriate hymns and songs of praise- using TEN TEN resources and our Wednesday Word leaflets

Now, starting a new term, we continue to teach our Religious Education syllabus 'Come and See' - The first theme of Domestic Church includes the following topics:

Year 1: Families

Year 2: Beginnings

Year 3: Homes

Year 4: People

Year 5: Ourselves

Year 6: Loving

We and the Archdiocese are categorically aware that for some children this will be the first school experience they have encountered since March 2020. Consequently the first topics for each year group have been amended and tweaked to incorporate and allow for discussion and dialogue within classroom lessons. This is to allow the children to explore views and opinions in the light of the uncertain times that we have and are still living in.
