Covid-19 update


If your child develops COVID symptoms, please inform school straight away and then book a test online through NHS testing. Alternatively, you can call NHS 119 to book if you are unable to access the internet.

Following these steps, you must also inform school immediately of the results of a test:

- If a pupil tests negative return to school the following day if they are well.
- If a pupil tests positive self-isolate for at least 10 days from the onset of their symptoms.

If a child tests positive, the pupils in their class / year group do <u>NOT</u> have to isolate unless advised to.
