

Reception Homework



Throughout the year we will send home a range of different activities that you can do at home to support your child's learning. This will link with the seven areas of learning: Communication & Language, Personal & Social Development, Physical Development, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design.

Homework will alternate between phonics and maths, including some activities based on our half termly topics or relevant celebration weeks or events. There will also be informative posts to help with your home learning such as phonics videos, links and top tips for reading with your child. Homework will be posted on Class Dojo on the Class Story every Monday and your child's work should be uploaded to your child's portfolio by the following Monday.

When the children have been introduced to the first few sets of letters and sounds they will be taught how to blend the sounds together for reading. All children will be given a home reading book with a reading record and a word card. The word cards will contain 'tricky' words that will be highlighted in red. Please encourage your child to learn these through sight recognition as these are the words which are most frequently found in books; it is important that children don't attempt to segment and blend these words but become so familiar to them that they are automatically read.



The reading book and word card should be kept in your child's book bag and sent into school every day.
